#### 1. INDICATION OF COSTS to be foreseen for VIBOT-MaIA programmes participation in France:

- **FEES** see our programme web sites : <http://www.vibot.org/>; <http://maiamaster.udg.edu/>  
Université de Bourgogne (UB) fee payment by self-funding students is to be done in two instalments. The exact amounts of the instalments will most probably be known in July 2018. Students will be informed of this by the Programme administration.
- **COST OF LIVING** (e.g. student housing, food, mandatory insurances for housing and student liability, transport) for study periods spent in Le Creusot, France, you should count on roughly 650-700€\* per month.  
\*This is the approximate amount for the monthly cost of living in Le Creusot, France. See with your Embassy/consular service (France, Spain, Italy for MaIA) to get confirmation and know the exact monthly amounts required for the visa application(s) to be done by you.
- **NEW : Contribution Vie Etudiante**  
As from academic year 2018-2019, students in France pay a Student Life Contribution (in French: "Contribution Vie Etudiante" - CVE) of 90€/student/academic year. According to the latest information, this mandatory contribution is managed by the CROUS, who will inform the students directly of this student services plan. CROUS issues a reference number upon payment of the contribution by the student. This reference number is to be submitted by the student to the university staff upon student registration. (Waiting for updates and confirmation on this topic)
- **INSURANCES**
  - French basic Social Security\* (or equivalent private scheme)  
\*NEW Changed enrolment situation as from September 2018. Students must be enrolled in the French General Social Security scheme. A transition year is foreseen for students who have been enrolled in 2017-2018 and already have a French Social Security number. Our programme students from 2017-2018 will indeed continue to be managed for an additional year in 2018-2019 by the SMEREB. We're waiting for further practical updates from national sources.
  - Student third party liability (compulsory for all)
  - Housing insurance (compulsory for all)
  - Complementary health insurance (strongly recommended)

#### 2. SECURING SUFFICIENT FINANCIAL RESOURCES:

Students must secure sufficient financial resources to cover the tuitions fees as well as the above-mentioned minimum monthly amount to cover all necessary expenses for the programme period. Proof of sufficient and secured resources will be required for visa application procedures.
